Terms of Reference

NBNU is committed to supporting students enrolled in the baccalaureate of nursing program. To this end it is offering, on a provincial basis, three (3) \$1,000 scholarships to students entering the first year of the baccalaureate in nursing program.

Who is eligible?

- A student enrolled in the first year of a baccalaureate of nursing program.
- The student must be a relative of a past or present NBNU member.
- The applicant must have maintained a good academic standing.

- Students must attach proof of acceptance into a nursing program
- Applicants must submit a 250 word essay on “Why you chose nursing” and the importance of “Unionism in Nursing”.
- Certification of academic achievement or letter of reference from a teacher/employer.
