Fredericton Area: IPC education sessions on guidelines and practices

Infection Prevention and Control has teamed up with educators from Learning Services in efforts to provide an education session on our guidelines and practices surrounding COVID-19 management of suspected/confirmed patients.

This session will include a visual demonstration of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Donning and Doffing (putting on and taking off). Our team may still reach out to individual units and departments to set up sessions as requests arise, however we are also setting up some drop-in sessions in efforts to reach as many staff as possible that may be directly affected.

While using PPE is not a new initiative, our participants have found it very helpful to have the opportunity to discuss the importance of properly putting on your PPE as well as the importance of minimizing the risk of self-contamination when taking PPE off.

We need to maintain the two metre (six foot) social distancing during these sessions, so please keep this in mind when arriving for attendance. While we should be able to accommodate a fairly large group for each session, please be aware that we may have to turn some away if social distancing cannot be maintained. More sessions may be added as needed.
