

Travel Guidelines for Health Care Workers

| Outside of Canada | Day 1 testing done as per federal requirements followed by sentinel testing Day 5 and 10 as applicable. If not immediate return to the workplace, testing done 24 hours prior to first return date to workplace and subsequent testing as required by Horizon protocol. | Day 1 testing done as per Federal requirements. Remain out of the workplace for 10 days with negative testing prior to return. Follow Work Isolation Guidelines. | Remain out of the workplace for 14 days. |

Employee Health: 1-833-978-2580

- Atlantic Provinces no restrictions
- Quebec no restrictions for fully vaccinated HCW's, others follow restrictions of the rest of Canada
- Western Canada beginning in Ontario:
 - o Must provide Employee Health with documentation of vaccine status
 - O Agree to testing upon return to the workplace with notification to Employee Health regarding tests
 - o Health care workers are responsible to book their own swab <u>COVID-19 Testing and Tracing (gnb.ca)</u>
- Outside of Canada:
 - o Health care worker must have approval from manager
 - Must have applied for ArriveCan travel registration
 - Must provide Employee Health with documentation of vaccine status
 - o Agree to testing upon return to the workplace with notification to Employee Health regarding tests
 - O Health care workers are responsible to book their own swabs COVID-19 Testing and Tracing (gnb.ca)
