

### **New screening criteria for employees and physicians** entering facilities

The screening criteria for employees and physicians in Horizon will be changed effective tomorrow, April 28, 2021. While employees in the Miramichi, Moncton, and Saint John areas will continue with self-screening, all employees and physicians must be actively screened prior to entering any Horizon facility in the Fredericton and Upper River Valley Area.

Please review the updated screening questions below and remain familiar with them.

The updated questions and signage can be accessed here. All updated posters are available on the Coronavirus Skyline page.

If an employee or physician answers yes to any of the questions, they are not to enter the facility. They must contact Employee Health and Wellness (1-833-978-2580) for further

screening and possible referral to a COVID-19 assessment centre.

### **Public exposures**

If you were present at any of the below locations at the times indicated, you may still enter a Horizon facility provided that you did not answer **yes** to any of the above questions.

However, you must contact Employee Health and Wellness for further assessment:

- Digital World, Dundonald Street, Fredericton on April 22 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

- Swiss Chalet, Fredericton on April 23 from 3 to 4:30 p.m.
- Home Depot, Fredericton on April 23 from 1 to 5 p.m.



## Temporary COVID-19 Testing Clinic established in Nackawic

In response to a recent cluster of COVID-19 positive cases in Zone 3, the Fredericton and Upper River Valley area, Horizon is









establishing a temporary, appointment-only COVID-19 Testing Clinic in Nackawic.

The temporary, appointment-only clinic will be operational noon to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, April 28, Thursday, April 29, and Friday, April 30.

This outdoor, drive-through testing clinic is located in the parking lot of the Nackawic Shopping Mall (135 Otis Dr.).

 Please note: If you are an employee or physician in Nackawic, and would like to be referred to this clinic, please continue to follow Horizon guidelines for COVID-19 testing by calling Employee Health at 1-833-978-2580

Please select "Hartland" as your preferred site until "Nackawic" becomes an option. When you are called for an appointment, indicate that you wish to be tested at the temporary site in Nackawic.

### **Vaccinations for Staff and Physicians Returning from Leave**

Invitations were sent to Horizon emails, therefore employees and physicians who have been out on leave may have missed this invitation.



### **GNB Updated Guidance on Astrazeneca**

In follow up to the memo of March 29 2021 entitled, "UPDATED Guidance on the Astrazeneca COVID-19 Vaccine", and in response to evolving information on this issue, please find <a href="here">here</a> a clinical algorithm for the investigation of vaccine induced immune thrombotic thrombocytopenia, a rare event that can follow COVID-19 vaccination, and has been noted following Astrazeneca vaccine specifically.
