John was a long standing proud NBNU member who was involved at both the provincial and local level for many years, he was dedicated to life-long learning and had a Bachelor of Education and a Bachelor of Nursing. John taught academic upgrading at NBCC. John spent most of his career in the long-term care sector working at the Miramichi Senior Citizens home and before his passing he was very involved when talks started in 2016 about the plans for Shannex to build a new nursing home to replace the Miramichi Senior Citizen and Mount Saint Joseph Nursing Home. It's not always easy for a nurse to deal with or speak about conflicts in the workplace, but he saw the implications to the members and residents and knew he had to do something.

This scholarship dedicated to John's activism and memory is a small, yet significant gesture, to ensure his memory lives on for years to come. It emphasizes the importance of continued learning and taking every opportunity to do so in life.

An appointed subcommittee of the NBNU Board of Directors will make the selection of the successful recipient.
