

CFNU Indigenous Nursing Scholarship



Terms of Reference

The Canadian Federation of Nurses Unions (CFNU) is committed to supporting indigenous students enrolled in a nursing program. To this end, CFNU is offering a \$1,000 scholarship to assist indigenous students in accredited nursing programs (BScN or LPN program) in each Canadian province. It is hoped that indigenous students who avail themselves of the New Brunswick scholarship will demonstrate nursing leadership within their provincial nurses union in the future. As a federation member, the New Brunswick Nurses Union sets the eligibility criteria and selects the candidate.

Who is eligible?

- One indigenous student enrolled in the first year of a nursing program (BScN or LPN Program).
- The applicant must be a relative of a past or present NBNU member.
- The applicant must have maintained a good academic standing.

How to apply

- Complete the application form (below)
- Submit a 250-word essay on "The Importance of Unionism in the Work Life of Nurses."
- Attach a certification of academic achievement (transcript of academic record) or letter of reference from teacher(s).
