Terms of Reference

NBNU is committed to supporting students enrolled in non-nursing post-secondary education programs. To this end it is offering, on a provincial basis, three (3) \$1,000 scholarships to the children of NBNU members enrolled in a non-nursing community college or university program.

Who is eligible?

- Student enrolled in a non-nursing community college or university program.
- Children of current NBNU members.
- The applicant must have maintained a good academic standing.

How to apply

- Complete the application form (below)
- Attach proof of acceptance or enrollment in a non-nursing post-secondary education program.
- Submit a maximum of 250-word essay on "How Have Unions Helped Shape Today's Workforce."
- Attach a certification of academic achievement (transcript of academic record) or letter of reference from teacher(s).
